Enrolling into Years 8 - 12– Farrer MAHS

During July, upon receipt of your son's half yearly report you are required to complete a Year 8-12 application available from <http://www.schools.nsw.edu.au/schoolfind/types/selectiveschools.php> or contact the Enrolments Officer at Farrer MAHS. We require a current school report, plus any other supporting documentation, including a photograph of your son. Please forward to Farrer MAHS.

Applicants will be interviewed during August (Year 11) & September (Years 8, 9 & 10) to enable the Principal, Deputy Principal and Year Co-Ordinator to establish a priority list for the following year.

The school has a limit in the number of boarder and day places that can be enrolled at Farrer. Should a current student wish to change from a boarder to a day student a formal application & interview is required. As vacancies become available offers will be made from the priority list created by the Farrer Selection Committee

Please send your completed application form, with attached documentation to the Enrolments Officer Farrer Memorial Agricultural High School, 585 Calala Lane, Tamworth 2340.

Years 8 to 10 interviews are arranged during September each year, you will be contacted by the Enrolments Officer to arrange a suitable time.

Offer of Placement:

Upon receipt of an offer of placement, a non refundable acceptance fee (approx. \$520) is required with your enrolment form. Cheques payable to Farrer MAHS are placed in a trust account and debited to your sons accounts upon enrolment at Farrer.

FEE SCHEDULE

All Students

A General School Contribution of \$243.00 per annum applies to all students. However, there may be some additional material costs involved for projects in some subjects.

A Compulsory Bond Deposit of \$120 is to be paid by each student upon acceptance to Farrer. This bond shall be refunded after the student completes their studies and submits a "Leavers Form" which indicates they have returned all text books.

FACILITIES LEVY

Day students — \$150.00 *per annum*

Boarding students — \$200.00 *per term for 3 terms = \$600 per annum*

New Enrolments please note your Acceptance Fee will be credited to your son's account upon enrolment.

Boarding Students

Boarding Fee is approved by the Minister for Education. Any changes are usually in accordance with CPI and are minimal. Transport for all boarders is subsidised by the government for travel to their home address on leave weekends and school holidays.
