## *Enrolling into Year 7– Selective Schools*

During Year 5 of primary school, inform your son's Principal, you intend to seek enrolment at Farrer MAHS for Year 7. During *November* you should be issued with a **Year 7 Entry to Selective High Schools application package** from your local government school. If you are in a non-government school you may request a package from Farrer MAHS 67648611 or your DEET Regional Office, a sample application form is available on the Selective Schools website but **cannot be used** for application purposes. <http://www.schools.nsw.edu.au/schoolfind/types/selectiveschools.php>

### **Changes Please note:**

2009 Application – Each form contain a **unique barcode**, complete forms using a **BLACK PEN** in **BLOCK** letters within the boxes shown.

### *Completed Forms:*

Please take your completed form to the Principal of your son's current school by November. Primary Principals should make comment on this form and return directly to Selective Schools Unit. Some Principals may choose not to complete this section of the form. If this is the case, you must contact Selective Schools by email or telephone 02 9707 6262 to request an Exemption Form, to enable your application to be considered. The Principal submits your application directly to the Selective Schools Unit in Sydney. Important dates & contact details are on the cover of the Application Package.

### *Selective Schools Process:*

Selective Schools arrange test centres throughout the State and will contact you of your son's test centre. The Selective Schools exam is held mid-March each year. Selective School outcome letters/emails are sent during July. Should your son receive a offer, you are expected to accept or decline within 21 days of your offer.

# **FEE SCHEDULE**

## ***All Students***

A General School Contribution of \$243.00 per annum applies to all students. However, there may be some additional material costs involved for projects in some subjects.

A Compulsory Bond Deposit of \$120 is to be paid by each student upon acceptance to Farrer. This bond shall be refunded after the student completes their studies and submits a "Leavers Form" which indicates they have returned all text books.

### **FACILITIES LEVY**

Day students — \$150.00 *per annum*

Boarding students — \$200.00 *per term x 3 terms = \$600 per annum*

Acceptance Fee will be credited to your son's account upon enrolment

## ***Boarding Students***

Boarding Fee is approved by the Minister for Education. Any changes are usually in accordance with CPI and are minimal. Transport for all boarders is subsidised by the government for travel to their home address on leave weekends and school holidays.
