RULES

1. If you have a bicycle at school, it must be registered with Mr Gallagher and be kept in the bike shed or rack outside the bike shed. Both Dayboys and Boarders are to use these racks.
2. BICYCLES MUST BE CHAINED TO THE BIKE RACK WHEN NOT IN USE. The chain should be long enough to pass through both wheels and the frame, and be secured by a strong padlock to the bike rack. It is suggested that the chain be covered by plastic hose to protect the frame from scratches.
3. BOARDERS must not leave the school grounds with bikes, without the permission of the Duty Master.
4. The limits for Boarders riding are Calala shops and Nemingha shops, unless given permission by the Duty Master to ride elsewhere.
5. WEARING OF A HELMET IS COMPULSORY when riding.
6. Any student breaking the rules will have their bike IMPOUNDED IMMEDIATELY.
